We do not make any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting either of our website. We will not associate any data gathered from this site with any personally identifying information from any source. The Google analytics [Google privacy policy](#). and Joomla session cookies.

We would also like to know which sites you came from and the page you leave our site from. We use www.statcounter.com to do this.

Registration is required to download our extensions because we need a point of contact should it be necessary to notify of security releases. Only registered users can post in our forum because we wish to prevent Bots from spam posting. We do not sell or trade email addresses. And we do not spam the email addresses with adverts.

If we do want to collect personally identifiable information through our website, we will be up front about this. We will make it clear when we collect personal information and will explain what we intend to do with it.
